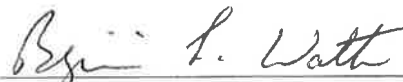
On May 11, 2011, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of First Bank of Delaware (the "Bank") appointed Mr. Joseph W. "Chip" Marshall to serve as a Class II Director until the 2012 annual meeting of shareholders. Mr.

Marshall's appointment fills a vacancy on the Board left by the death of a former director. Mr. Marshall has been appointed to serve on the Board's Audit Committee. He is also a member of the Board's Asset Liability, Nominating, Directors Compliance, Compliance and Risk Management, and Option and Compensation Committees. Mr. Marshall is Vice Chairman of the law firm Stevens and Lee and was the President and CEO of Temple University Health System. Mr. Marshall serves as a Member of The Board of Trustees for Temple University and he is a Member of The CEO Council for Growth. He has been elected as a Fellow into the College of Physicians of Philadelphia. Mr. Marshall is a member of numerous Boards and is a former member of the Pennsylvania State Ethics Commission. He also served as a member of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Medicaid Commission created by Congress.
